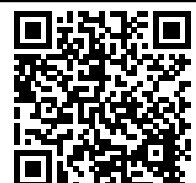

George Gregory was a marine painter, the son of the artist Charles Gregory. Living and painting in the Isle of Wight, George inherited his father's talent and zeal for seascapes. It is said that George Gregory was asked to teach Queen Victoria's children to paint when they were staying at Osbourne House, but he either declined the honour or gave up the task after a few lessons. Gregory had a great knowledge and love of the sea and this is reflected in the accuracy and merit of his marine paintings.
