Below this is a drawer which can be opened when a steel rod is lifted up. This drawer contains a couple of glass measuring beakers and some other accessories and bottles. The mahogany box is in excellent condition and is strong and sturdy with a beautiful patina. There are some small knocks and marks but no major damages and the inside is generally clean and tidy. It also comes with its original working key. There are no major damages to any of the glass bottles. There are some nibbles and small chips around the tops of some of them but nothing serious and the contents of the drawer are also in excellent condition.
