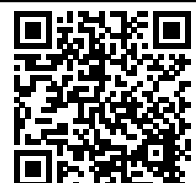
Description

Edmund Morris Wimperis VPRI 1835-1900. Landscape painter and watercolourist. Born in Chester. Studied wood engraving under Mason Jackson, and worked as an illustrator for Illustrated London News and other magazines. Exhibited from 1859 at RA, SS, NWS, GG, NG and elsewhere. Elected ARI 1873, RI 1875, VPRI 1895. Like Cox and Collier, who was his frequent painting companion in the late 1870s and 1880s. Like Cox and Collier, he was fond of black and windswept moorland scene.
