Two flanges to the front edge to aid opening, the lid opens to reveal an immaculate gilded interior with hinged fretwork panel to keep the scented sponge behind. Bears the makers mark for silversmith William Lea along with clear hallmarks to all sections. Superbly detailed throughout and presented in immaculate condition.
