He exhibited nine works at the Royal Academy, the later of these including "The Meeting of Henrietta Maria and Marie de Medici"; "King Solomon and the Queen of Sheba" and "The Separation of Sir Thomas More and his family". He also exhibited five works at SS and four works at the British Institute.
