This five stone diamond ring is hallmarked to the interior shank with the 18ct gold mark (18CT) and platinum mark (PLAT). This impressive 1930s ring is supplied with three IDGL diamond grading report certificates for the feature stones, in addition to an IDGL diamond grading report card for the supporting stones. Such original examples with evenly matched diamonds are becoming increasingly difficult to locate; the goldsmith has finely hand-selected these diamonds to create a well-colour matched display, indicating the high quality of the piece.
