Rowan, 'Keir-Perthshire-III' Country Life, 29 August 1975, p.510 and another similar was supplied to William Gibbs Esq for Tyntesfield by J G Crace in 1855-6 for £17 -6 and is presently in the library there now open to view through the National Trust
