Of low oval form, with mask head handles, the cover surmounted by an imposing eagle finial, painted with deep blue bands enlivened with neoclassical gilt borders, on a salmon pink ground, the rectangular plinth foot with further gilt decoration and edged in black enamel, 24cm high, impressed crowned BFB mark, script mark with Coventry Street address.
