Description

A rare witch scrying mirror, dating from the late 19th or early 20th century, carved as a cross-legged figure wearing a tall wide-brimmed hat with long hair and holding head in hands, with original mirror glass. These witch mirrors are usually attributed to being of Welsh, Cornish or Black Forest origin. A similar example can be found in the Museum of Witchcraft and Magic in Boscastle, Cornwall.
