Not all Windsor chairs had crinoline stretchers, especially child's examples, and most have standard H stretchers to support the legs, but there is something incredibly elegant about the swept crinoline stretchers. It is believed the term crinoline is borrowed from the crinoline petticoats which 19th century ladies would utilise below their dresses to enhance their silhouette. Generally Windsor chairs are one of the most widely produced, widely used and widely loved items of antique furniture. They come in just about every design, size, quality, timber and period that it's possible to imagine, with Windsor chairs still being constructed to this very day and often costing more to purchase than the antique versions.
