Lower drawer hosts four further sections, including a pair of lidded caddies for tools or ingredients. Through pin with polished brass tip secures the lower drawer for travel or display. Fascia adorned with a shield-shaped lock escutcheon — key absent. Displays a fine balance of form and function, perfect for collectors of campaign or medical antiques. A delightfully presented example of Georgian field apothecary design, this antique box makes for an intriguing conversation piece or display cabinet centrepiece.
