Description

William Wyld RI 1806-1809. Landscape and topographical painter, mainly in watercolour. Lived mostly in Paris where he became a close friend of Bonington who was an influence on his work. Exhibited mainly at NWS, also at RA 1852-54, and at BI. Elected ARI 1849 RI 1879. Painted English and French landscapes and views, also in other parts of Europe, especially Venice. He played an important part in the development of watercolour in France. He was awarded two medals at the Salon, and given the Legion d'Honneur in 1855.
