Raised on 6 carved scrolled legs terminating in lion paw feet, the ebonised finish having the perfect amount of ware. Upholstered in Robert Kime Raby Red fabric with a velvet and studded trim. Stamped, English, Circa 1850. Dimensions: Height: 47 cm - 18 1/2 Inches, Width: 244 cm - 96 Inches, Depth: 115.5 cm - 45 1/2 Inches *The firm of Holland & Sons (1803-1942) became from 1843 one of the largest and most successful cabinet makers, and a rival to Gillows of Lancaster and London. The company's labelled Day books are now housed in the Victoria and Albert Museum Archive of Art and Design where they present a virtual 'who's who' of nineteenth century society. Established in 1803 by Stephen Taprell and William Holland, a relation of the architect Henry Holland (architect). Always on the leading edge of fashion, Holland & Sons employed some of England's foremost designers and participated in all of the International Exhibitions of 1851, 1855, 1862, 1867, 1872 and 1878.
