Hinged scroll design carrying handle to the top and complementing silver gilt bun feet to the base. Clasp to the side for releasing the rear door, which opens to reveal a silver gilt hinge and Paris made movement with platform escapement. Bears the makers mark for highly regarded London silversmith William Comyns along with clear hallmarks.
