There is an undulating silver rim, with a reserve for the spoon and the glass is a lovely blue/grey colour. The preserve spoon has a shaped bowl and bright cut engraving to the handle, with a vacant shield shaped cartouche. Both practical and decorative, this lovely duo has many uses apart from preserves and would grace any well laid table. Dimensions below.
