Hall was born to Eliza Robinson in the City of York in 1859 and his name was initially registered as Henry Robinson, but his mother subsequently married John Storey Hall in August of 1867, hence the change of his surname to Robinson Hall. He moved to Newcastle upon Tyne, in northern England and by 1885, he was residing in Flyde, in Lancashire, where he married his wife Mary...

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
