A small English William IV period bracket clock. Good colour and patination to the rosewood case with a gadroon top and wooden finial. Chamfered brass front sides and brass arched side window apertures. A quality timepiece fusee mechanism of 8-day duration with locking pendulum feature. A well engraved arched silvered dial with 'moon' blued steel hands. Circa 1835. Whitmore & Son of Northampton are recorded in Loomes' 'Watchmakers and Clockmakers of The World' book as working 1830-1864. These small 'library' bracket clocks are hard to find.
