Of Campana form, with gilded gadrooned rims, each vase very finely painted with topographical views framed within raised paste gilded borders, one vase with a scene of 'Pont Y Rhydlanfair near Capel Curig, Caernarfonshire' and the other with 'Denbigh Castle', all reserved on a green ground, the square plinth bases picked out in gold and bronze, the classical style loop handles with gilt rams-head terminals. Script factory mark referring to Coventry Street address along with scene titles in red. Condition: In excellent condition with just a crack to the base of one handle, tiny restored chip to the base of one vase and a chip to the underside of the other vase.
