The two rose-cut diamonds are set into recessed sockets, offering subtle sparkle that adds to the mystique of this symbolic piece. The snake motif, popular throughout the Victorian and Edwardian eras, has long symbolised eternal love, wisdom and protection. Beautifully weighted and proportioned, this ring makes a strong statement and looks magnificent on the hand. Width across the head: 11mm, tapering to 7.6mm at the back.
