The movement is of 8-day duration and strikes the full hours and half hours on a bell giving a very pleasant mellow chime. This clock has spent most of the last 150 years under a glass dome, and it is in totally original condition with no losses or additions, cracks or chips. The enamel decoration on the porcelain panels is beautifully preserved with no signs of abrasions due to over cleaning.
