These clocks feature specific red and green sectors on the dial, indicating periods of silence for radio communication. The red sectors, typically from 16 to 18 minutes and 46 to 48 minutes, mark times for Morse code telegraphy, while the green sectors, from 1 to 3 minutes and 31 to 33 minutes, denote periods for radio telegraphy.
