Description

19th century oil on canvas of a bay horses head with canvas headcollar. The painting is mounted in a simple gilt frame and is signed by the artist - Jos Schippers. Schippers was a Belgian artist who was born in Antwerp in 1868 and who died in Deurne in 1950. He was the grandson of the painter Charles Schippers and educated at the Academy in Antwerp under the direction of Brunin and P. Van Havermaet. Then from 1893 at the Higher Institute in Antwerp. He was a painter, etcher of portraits, animals, figures, marines and landscapes. Monkeys were his favorite animals which he associated with human characteristics in a wide variety of scenes, all painted in a realistic style. As a great admirer of Charles Verlat, Schippers enjoyed his training at the Antwerp Academy under the direction of Leon Brunin and Pieter Van Havermaet.
