Description

Rare oil on canvas of a pair of Andalucian horse riders/Spanish riders in a town with a lady to one side. The painting is by the artist Charles Bisschops (1894 - 1975). The painting is well executed and is mounted in a super frame with slip an is under glass. Bisschops was a Belgium painter and drawer of landscapes, portraits and compositions. He became a pupil of the Academy of Brussels from 1912. Here he was fortunate to have as his principal professors the great artists Constant Montald and Jean Delville whose joint influences were to have a profound effect on the young artist. In 1914 he volunteered to join the Belgian army at the outbreak of WWI and even though he was wounded on two separate occasions, he managed to remain on the line until the Armistice of 1918. After the war he returned for one year to the Academy of Brussels to complete his studies and it was here that he met his future wife Lucienne, the daughter of the sculptor Jules Coessens. They married in 1920 and the following year both traveled to Algeria, the start of a series of sojourns that would include trips to France, Italy and Spain over the next ten years.
