Sympathetically refinished in our workshops and now offered for sale in very good condition with a good colour and patina. Splits into 2 sections for ease of installation. Comes with provenance. Dimensions: Width 164cms Depth 40cms Height 199cms Internal shelf depth 29cms The Hille furniture company was started in the East End of London in 1906 by Salomon Hille, a Russian emigrant, to renovate and reproduce eighteenth century furniture. The focus of the business was very much quality rather than large volumes, employing skilled craftsmen and gaining customers such as Hamptons, a well known furniture store, amongst others. By the 1930's the company had established an international reputation supplying products all over the world. Salomon's daughter, Ray, subsequently joined the company.

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
