Features realistic hand-painted details in purple, pink, and blue, embodying both artistic finesse and functional design. Kuznetsov was Russia's preeminent porcelain producer, eventually supplying the Imperial Court. Pieces of this calibre are seldom available, representing museum-level Russian decorative art and a solid investment. Stamped under base with the blue Imperial eagle and Kuznetsov mark. Height: 12.7 cm, Length: 20.5 cm, Width: 10 cm. Weight: 442g.
