The chair is fresh back from the workshop from having expert conservation and best described as mostly excellent condition, it has been through our workshop for strengthening on joints, a stable and original chair that sits well and with no loss or defects to the fretwork carving, please see photos. Evidence of historic repair circa early 20th century to the back rest upper section with the fitting of 2 bespoke iron straps at the back, see photos. A wonderful antique chair of considerable decorative appeal, a versatile interior design chair of both function and form that can enhance a classic or contemporary space, for a day or bedroom etc..
