The simplicity of design and well figured timber, in combination with the good colour and surface creates real elegance. Another feature of note is the very unusual humped feet which appear to have been inspired by rarely found and extremely sought after manx designs. Its a good useful size, perfect for a lamp and some photo frames, or perching a drink, or any other function which one requires. Overall the condition is good. As mentioned before it retains a good colour and patina. Within that patina are a few old marks, scuffs, scrapes etc which have blended nicely into the surface and help create that lovely untouched surface.
