In hearty appreciation of his work as Lay Reader. April 1897 - August 1900". The wood has a nice rich colour and the whole piece is in very good condition with no major damages and revolves freely. There are signs of age and use, some minor knocks and light marks but nothing untoward or detrimental. It has been cleaned and lightly polished and is ready for use.
