Both the chairs are in superb, clean and strong condition and all are complete with the original seagrass rushed seats, that are all intact and strong. They are very interesting cabinet makers who worked closely with Bernard Leach designing and making the famous pottery wheels and artist Ben Nicholson whom he made the canvas stretchers for his paintings. He also made all Barbara Hepworth's sculpture and display stands, Dicon Nance was her assistant until 1971.
