Description

This exceptional matched pair of large porcelain figures was produced by Eichwald (later Royal Dux, Bohemia, now Czechia) in the early 20th century. The male figure bears a rare relief inscription "1905 HAMPEL" on the base—a virtually unseen feature for Royal Dux/Eichwald, as most pieces only carry model numbers. Here, full sculptor attribution is preserved, adding immense value. Dimensions and Weight: Male musician with Pan flute: height 43 cm, width 15 cm, depth 13 cm, weight 1928g. Female musician with mandolin: height 44.5 cm, width 18 cm, depth 12 cm, weight 1942g. Condition: Male: tip of Pan flute chipped, minor chips to laurel wreath leaves. Female: end of mandolin handle chipped, left pinky finger missing, small chip to base corner touched up with green paint. Otherwise, both figures remain in excellent antique condition, retaining vivid painting, fine modelling and original details. About the Artist: Alois Hampel (1840–1912) was the chief sculptor and designer at the Eichwald factory from the late 1880s until around 1910. He elevated the factory's status to a leader of European art porcelain, and his finest, most refined models date specifically from the p...

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
