The mirror is supported on a rectangular base with three drawers, each with its original brass ring handles and escutcheon, perfect for storing small personal items or jewellery and with lock and key. The rich mahogany grain has developed a warm patina over nearly three centuries, highlighting the craftsmanship of the Georgian era. Raised on shaped bracket feet, this mirror is both decorative and functional, circa 1740
