An Arts and Crafts antique silver sterling silver hat pin cushion by the highly revered Edward Spencer for the Artificer's Guild. It is clearly hallmarked for London 1928 and is in a domed cylindrical drum form with washed silk cushion. The silver ring has applied rope twist bordered roundels of alternating eagles, roses and ouroboros (circular motifs of snakes swallowing their tail) motifs. Highly unusual and fabulous. Dimensions: Height: 6cm Diameter: 13cm The Artificer's Guild was first set up in 1901 and despite financially problematic early years proved to be one of the few commercially successful craft guilds. Although initially led by Nelson Dawson, Edward Spencer was the most influential designer during the golden age of the guild. Post and packaging are free within the UK.
