Gold stylized leaves on the spout. Each side has two birds on a branch and insects: beetles, butterflies, bees. Part of the Meissen "Naturalistic Birds and Insects" series, first created after the 1740s and made in small numbers through the 19th century. This jug is a typical example of Meissen's naturalistic decoration, combining careful handpainting and high quality porcelain. Marked with underglaze blue crossed swords.
