Dimensions: height with handle 14cm, without 11cm; width 8cm; depth 6.3cm; weight 785g. Substantial brass case with original patina, all bevelled glass panels present and free from damage. Porcelain dial, original hands, and double-ended key. The clock is in good working order, keeps accurate time, mechanism is clean and runs reliably. The alarm mechanism is present and complete: the disc is original, rotates freely, and the alarm function worked once when tested (not repeated to avoid possible wear—alarm disc may require minor tightening for everyday use). Backplate bears the "DLB" clover mark, "Bté SGD", "Made in France". All setting levers intact and operational. No restoration, no excessive cleaning; original untouched finish. A fine, honest collector's piece with fully working timekeeping. Please study the accompanying photographs carefully as they form an integral part of this description.
