Charming Painted Dial for G & T Kidds Malton with Attractive Bird Decoration Probably of a Jay. The 30 Hour Movement has been Tested to be in Good Working Order. The Kidd Family of Clockmakers were associated with Malton Yorkshire Circa 1760 with Gilbert (I) who died in 1788. G & T Kidds dates from the late 18th Century and may well Relate to Gilbert (II), Nephew of Gilbert (I), and Thomas Kidd who is Recorded as Working at Westgate, Malton, Yorks 1807-1823.
