A finely painted Kyoto Satsuma charger, late Meiji period (c.1885–1900), signed Kyokuzan beneath the Shimazu crest. The lobed rim frames panels with courtly figures, florals and landscape; microscopic stippling, textile patterns and raised gilding demonstrate top Kyoto school workmanship associated with the Kinkozan studio tradition. Dimensions: diameter 25 cm; height 6 cm; weight 891 g. Condition: one rim chip and light rubbing to the gilt edge; no visible cracks or restorations. Investment note: signed Kyoto Satsuma of this quality and period is scarce and actively collected; comparable examples feature in major collections (e.g. Kyoto/Khalili).
