The painting is in good antique condition with the odd minor mark but the colours are bright and true. The piece is framed in a period rosewood frame of good colour and figuring. The work retains a wonderful label on the reverse inscribed thus: Punch My faithful friend for ten years and now in the care of Lady Scott 'The first' Newbury Jany 1890 A really charming piece with a great story and the perfect country house look.
