Priest 1&2 Tudor Street Blackfriars. The elegant table is raised on elegant reeded tapering legs that terminate in brass caps and original brass castors. Made in England, circa 1790, this writing table boasts a rich mahogany brown colour and is in superb original condition. The figured mahogany exhibits a rich, warm patina, perfectly complemented by the exquisite brown/black tooled leather top.
