The lower bureau section includes a classic fall-front writing flap, which opens to reveal a fitted interior comprising: A green leather inset writing surface Eight pigeonholes Four small drawers ideal for storing stationery A central drop well compartment for additional storage Beneath the writing section are two short drawers above two long drawers, with decorative brass swan neck handles.
