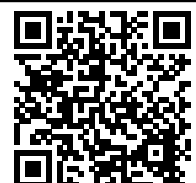

He was the eldest son of farmer John Edward Bale (1803-1862) and his wife Mary Nee Branford 1813-1899. In 1861 aged 26, John moved to 11 Bulstrode Street, Marylebone, London. He was an Ensign in the 1st West Indian Regiment. Whilst on tour, John embellished Surgeon Major Augustus Frederick Eliotts diary with calligraphy and watercolour titles. The diary is now kept at Duke University Library. John was promoted to Captain during his tour and later retired from the army in 1881 as major. He married Charlotte Gordon Lee Nee Johnson at Christ Church, Ealing November 10th 1868. Bale was a...
