Description

A pair of German porcelain figures produced by the Oldest Volkstedt Porcelain Factory, Thuringia, circa 1915. Both figures are modelled in the Dresden style, each on a circular base with a relief gilt border and painted in rich polychrome enamels.

The group depicts a rural scene: the boy holding a birdcage and feeding a bird with a worm, and the girl carrying a large flower basket.

The female figure is marked with the well-known Volkstedt crown and 1762 underglaze blue mark introduced as the factory's 150th anniversary emblem in 1915. The male figure bears an export mark applied by a partner company for the British market, reflecting the period practice of supplying undecorated blanks for finishing by associated studios.
