Both men moved to the Isle of Man from Manchester and were professional artists/photographers. The youngest of five children to George Bagnall Bradshaw and Mary Dorothea Champion, Bradshaw was born in Cheetham, Manchester in 1858. His birth name was Joseph Wright Bradshaw, but at an unknown date he changed it to Joseph Cecil Bradshaw. In 1871 the census referred to Bradshaw as a 'scholar' at 12 years old, suggesting he underwent schooling in Manchester. It is unclear whether or not he received any formal artistic training. In 1879, Bradshaw married Emily Jan Slinger. It seems that during this period he was working as an artist and photographer, but in 1887, the partnership between Bradshaw and William Temple Battersby in the business of Ar...

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
