Description

A rare matched pair of Wedgwood lustre three-handled Loving Mugs, designed by Daisy Makeig-Jones circa 1915. The first mug matches Decoration Book pattern Z4827: Ruby Lustre exterior with butterflies and oriental motifs; Mother-of-Pearl Lustre interior with a butterfly. Base stamped Wedgwood with pattern number. The second mug has a green lustre exterior with a coiled gilt snake on one side and a dancing dragon on the reverse. Inside, on a green-toned Mother-of-Pearl Lustre, the central medallion shows the snake enclosing a small monkey. Base with factory stamp; pattern number worn with age. Both mugs feature three loop handles with a single gilt line and gilt rims. Among the most popular shapes used for Wedgwood lustre decoration were bowls and the three-handled Loving Mugs, and this pair illustrates Makeig-Jones's imaginative use of color and fantastical imagery.
