His works typically feature small fishing communities, harbours, and atmospheric seascapes painted en plein air, with a keen eye for architectural detail and shoreline life. Mitchell's watercolours from the 1870s–1880s are held in private collections and appear occasionally at regional auctions, where their location-specific charm appeals to collectors of Scottish art. Provenance: Purchased in the past from Atholl Antiques, a respected Scottish dealer known for fine period furniture, paintings, and decorative art.
