James Thomas Watts RCA RBSA 1853-1930. Liverpool landscape painter, who exhibited from 1873, at the RA from 1878, SS, NWS, GG, RBSA and elsewhere; titles at the RA, including 'Beech Trees in the Winter', 1878, 'A Bright Day on the Barmouth Sands' 1881, and 'The Gypsies Haunt', 1903. The Fuller Collection of Watercolours, auctioned by Christie's in 2000 contained nineteen examples by the artist with 'A Woodland Landscape in Winter' 33x 26.7 cms realised £18213 and 'Natures Cathedral' 49x30.2 cms realised £12925. This fine example has been professionally cleaned by my excellent restorer and is housed in its original frame.
