A beautiful Chelsea-Derby porcelain Dessert Dish c.1784 - 1788. The circular dish, with scalloped rim, the cavetto very finely decorated with the scene of a Cherub standing on clouds in the manner of Richard Askew. The border decorated with panels of single roses against a white background and a band of 'Smith's Blue' with gilt foliate ornament by Thomas Soar and painted white enamel 'jewels'. Gilders mark '1' in puce in the footrim for Thomas Soar and a Crown over cross batons and the letter 'D' to the centre of the reverse. Condition: Good with no cracks or restoration. Very small chip to the rim on the reverse. Some surface scratches to the central painted panel. Literature: The Marks on Chelsea-Derby by Stephen Mitchell - Plate 80 III where a dish of the same shape is illustrated.
