A very impressive astounding quality antique 19th century bronze Clodion statue of a pair of classical Bacchus influenced dancing maidens with their children holding a tambourine, signed by Clodian. A glorious piece displaying incredible detail and first rate craftsmanship having been crafted by one of the most important sculptors of the 19th century. Clodion or Claude Michel, 1738-1814, French rococo sculptor. He executed several important commissions under Louis XVI but is best remembered for his bas-reliefs and small figure groups in bronze and terra-cotta representing fauns, nymphs, and children.
