The clock has a later Victorian shaped plinth which doesn't look out of place at all. The movement is 8 day striking on a bell at the hour and the date works. The simple early painted dial is beautifully done and very stylish. The clock has been fully serviced. Just a really nice elegant, slim Scottish longcase.
