Edward Horace Thompson (1879–1949) – Thirlmere with Helvellyn, Lake District, Watercolour, 1925 Subject & Medium An original watercolour on paper by Edward Horace Thompson, depicting the tranquil Thirlmere reservoir with the towering Helvellyn mountain in the Lake District, Cumbria. Dated 1925, the work is preserved beneath glass, ensuring the survival of its subtle tonal variations and refined brushwork. Composition & Technique The composition demonstrates Thompson's mastery of atmosphere and perspective. The reflective white light upon the lake contrasts with deeper tones of water, while the foreground is enlivened with green grasses, purple heather, and a single prominent tree rising from the slope. Rolling hills guide the eye toward distant mountains, softly veiled in mist. Warm golden light touches the left-hand ridges, while overhead a dynamic sky alternates between cloud and patches of clear blue. His restrained yet vivid palette of greens, browns, purples, whites, greys, and blues creates a harmonious and balanced landscape.
