This piece exemplifies the classic craftsmanship of Christofle, a French silversmith house celebrated for its luxurious silver-plated and sterling silver creations. Highly detailed, chased designs depicting winged celestial figures, likely Kinnaris, a common motif in Burmese art and mythology, often found on traditional silver offering bowls. These figures, portrayed in a seated or lounging posture, are intricately rendered with flowing hair and prominent wings, set against a textured, stippled background.
